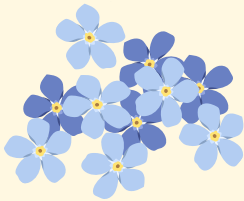

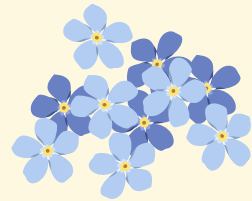
Memorial Donations
